Meeting publishers, distributors, agents and TV producers from all over the world often make the difference for a multiplication of copyright sales in many countries, but also for future projects. Having a rights table at the Paris Cookbook Fair allows professionals to meet the most important people in the international cookbook market.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS PAYMENT OPTIONS

THE EVENT

1. The event will take place between Monday, November 29th, 2021, and Monday, December 6th 2021. The opening hours are from 10 am to 10 pm. The event is only for professionals with badges, and opens for the general public during the week-end.

BADGES

2. Each badge includes an entry in the professional catalog and full access to the different events (Gourmand Awards, Paris Cookbook Fair, Sustainable Food Congress and World Cuisines Market) during seven days. Entrance to the Gourmand Awards and the Rights Tables area is strictly reserved for professionals with badges.

RIGHTS TABLES

3. Each Rights Table includes an entry in the professional catalog, one table, one sign with the exhibitor's name and four chairs. General surveillance and patrols of the exhibition site and the halls are performed by a company contracted by the Organiser. At night, all valuable and easily removable objects must be securely locked away by the Exhibitor.

EXHIBITORS

4. All international companies involved in the creation, preparation and distribution of content via media such as books, reports, newspapers, periodicals, teaching materials and videos may exhibit at the Paris Cookbook Fair. Food and drinks are exhibited at the World Cuisines Market. The Organiser does not apply any form of censorship.

FORCE MAJEURE

5. Force majeure or other compelling reasons entitle the Organizer to postpone the event. In that case, the event would take place on March 2022.

INVOICING

 After the registration is received, the Organiser will promptly send out an invoice. Exhibitors based in EU member states (outside of Spain) need to declare their VAT identification number on the registration form.
